Subject: Milling and Paving of City Streets

Issue: Staff is requesting authorization from the Governing Body to enter into an agreement with Branscome Paving Company for milling and paving services per pricing in Attachment A and subject to City Attorney review and approval.

Background:

- Maintenance and repair of pavement on City streets is continuously required to preserve the life of City streets. The City has appropriate equipment to perform small pavement repairs but when large areas of pavement are damaged, staff must use professional paving contractors.
- As a result of severe ice and snow during the previous winter of 2009/2010, large areas of pavement are in disrepair throughout the west side of the City. While staff prefer to make the repairs with City resources, deterioration of paved surfaces has progressed beyond the capability of City equipment.
- Approved funding is available in the FY11 budget under "Additional Street Projects."
- The City's services agreement for milling and paving services expired in July 2010, and staff are seeking to enter into another agreement for milling / paving to address the damaged pavement areas.

Discussion:

- The City's previous agreement was with Branscome Paving and the company has a history of competitive pricing and good performance in the City.
- Branscome Paving executed an agreement with the City of Manassas ("Manassas") on July 1, 2010 for "Milling and Paving of City Streets and Parking Lots," which includes a "Rider Clause" in the Invitation for Bid that, per Virginia Procurement Law, allows other jurisdictions to ride the Manassas contract.
- Staff propose to ride the Manassas agreement, which provides unit pricing for specific tasks that the City needs for repair and maintenance of City streets. The unit pricing is based on "VDOT asphalt base index for June 2010."

Recommendation:

Authorize staff to enter into an agreement with Branscome Paving Company for milling and paving services per pricing in Attachment A and subject to City Attorney review and approval.
